Trustees Report

The renovation work is continuing in our Church at the Corner of Ponce and Highland. We have HVAC online in most of the building now, including the Sanctuary! Restrooms are all functional again and only need some finishing touches, the nursery is up and running where the library once stood, and the children's room upstairs where the choir room used to be is 97% finished. We continue work on the elevator as crews have to hand dig the underground portion for the elevator pit, and level the dirt to allow access to the theatre level. Due to some unforeseen issues with shoring of supporting walls the elevator is a few weeks behind schedule (it's always an adventure), and we will be looking for completion in mid-July. Upcoming new work will include reroofing the S.E. & S.W. wings of the church; that should begin the week of May 4th weather permitting. That should take care of all the leaks we've had in those areas over the last several years. We will also have safer access ladders and new roof top HVAC units installed. The work continues; in the meantime please excuse the dust!
